Public Comment:

- There was no public comment.

Correspondence:

- Municipal Election reminder. Michele Gray and Michelle Hillard both need to refile as their terms will expire this year.

Old Business:

Snow Removal – Wyrick Cons. is who we call to remove the snow. He is working with the Town and knows where the water valves are. If there is an emergency, he will be called sooner but otherwise the plan is to have him plow after the storm is over. If someone calls a third party to plow, they will be responsible for the bill, not the Town.

New Business:

- Dump site locks - The Town will be changing the locks on the dump site. Plevna Propane, the school and the Town will each have their own locks. Mark will get the locks and will get with Larry and Chad to give them their locks. Mark will work with G&G and Baker Metal for them to have access.
- Generac for Water Pump building – The generator was not working. Direct Electric ordered the part and TWE will get the part (a control panel) installed when they have someone available. This repair will be split between the Fire Dept and the Town.

Department Reports:

- **Water/Wastewater Operator** – Rick had nothing to report. Jolene got some chlorine test strips in and Rick will need to test the water in the O'Connor pit.
- **Container Site Operator** – Mark burned the brush pile.

- **Clerks Report** – Beth will call Seth to discuss the minimum allocation grant.


Approve Claims:
