ORDINANCE NO. 49-1

TO EXTEND THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF INTERIM ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 49.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PLEVNA, MONTANA:

Section 1: To protect the public safety, health, and welfare and without following the procedures otherwise required prior to the adoption of a zoning ordinance, a town council may adopt as an urgency measure an interim zoning ordinance prohibiting any uses that may be in conflict with a contemplated zoning proposal that the legislative body is considering or studying or intends to study within a reasonable time (76-2-306 MCA)

Section 2: This ordinance is applicable within the incorporated limits of the Town of Plevna and takes effect upon passage. A notice of public hearing was published in the Fallon County Times on September 25, 2015, October 2, 2015 and October 9, 2015.

The public hearing was held on October 12, 2015 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town of Plevna Office, 121 Main Street, Plevna, Montana. (76-2-306 MCA)

Section 3: This ordinance extends the effective date of Ordinance No. 49 which was passed and approved on March 9, 2015. This extension will be in effect for one year and will expire on September 9, 2016. (76-2-306 MCA)

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

The Plevna Town Council adopts interim zoning regulations as referenced in Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 49.
